NEIGHBORHOOD

Here is a short list of key things to be aware of and look for in your neighborhood. If you notice unusual behavior or conditions, contact law enforcement. Do not try to approach anyone you suspect of being a victim or perpetrator as you may be putting yourself in a dangerous situation.



- 1** Tenants or guests in a residence avoid eye contact or look overly anxious.
- 2** Person has few or no personal possessions. (May wear the same clothes frequently).
- 3** Someone who launders and seems to have no purpose in your neighborhood.
- 4** A lot of auto traffic in front of a certain residence.
- 5** School aged children who are not in school and don't appear to be homeschooling.
- 6** Interior locks on doors and windows.
- 7** Unfamiliar vehicles.
- 8** Potential victim seems malnourished or very thin.
