01

**It's a Social Group Crime**  
You can determine potential illegal activity by narrowing down segments of society.

**No Victim**

Men, women, boys, and girls are trafficked. Men who are trafficked are often reluctant to come forward due to social pressures.

**Big Events = Prime Activity**  
Large events are a distraction to human trafficking and should be prioritized for training and attention.

Although there is often an uptick in human trafficking during major events, narrow focus on these events takes away from the daily battle victims face. Bottom line: you don't need an event to have trafficking. The demand is ever-present.

**Buyers and Sellers Have a Profile**  
Sex traffickers and sex buyers fit certain profiles.

Although buyers of sex tend to have a higher education and more disposable income than the general population, no other stereotype holds true in the world of human sex trafficking. Every class, gender, race, creed, and education level are known to participate in sex trafficking.
